\$30 DISCOUNT VOUCHER FOR LA RESIDENTS

\$70 VOUCHER FOR LOW-INCOME & SENIOR LA RESIDENTS



If you are of low-income, on a government-assisted program, or over 65 years of age or older, then the Department may have programs to help you spay or neuter your pet for free. Or you may qualify for a \$30 voucher towards spay/neuter.

SPAY OR NEUTER YOUR PETS – IT'S THE LAW.

WHY SPAY OR NEUTER YOUR PET?



Here are just a few reasons why you should spay or neuter your animal companion.

ADVANTAGES FOR YOUR ANIMAL

- Spayed/neutered pets are less likely to roam away from home, be injured in fights or get lost.
- Altered pets live twice as long and are less likely to develop certain cancers. This means lower medical bills.
- Your animal friend is calmer.
- Spayed females will not have heat cycles and neutered males are less likely to mark furniture and rugs with urine.

ADVANTAGES FOR YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

- It reduces the amount of strays.
- It reduces the number of animals in your Los Angeles shelters.
- **It's the law.** All dogs and cats living in the City of Los Angeles over 4 months old must be altered. Violation of this ordinance could result in fines up to \$500.

WAYS TO QUALIFY

If you reside in Los Angeles, you are eligible for a \$30 discount certificate for use at a veterinary hospital contracted with LA Animal Services.

LOW-INCOME

Bring your DWP Bill indicating "Lifeline" or "Low Income" and you're qualified! Take your last bill to one of our Shelters and we'll give you a FREE voucher.

If you don't have a DWP Bill, we can still help! FREE vouchers are available to LA City residents who qualify based on proof of income:

SENIOR CITIZEN



Senior Citizens, 62 years of age or older, with a qualifying income level may qualify for a voucher covering the full cost of a companion animals' sterilization at a participating veterinary hospital.
